

TARGETED DESERT WEED CONTROL

A 2(ee) recommendation is now available for Flumishield SC for the control of Globe Chamomile.

Globe Chamomile, also known as Stinknet, is an invasive weed that has become established in parts of Arizona. It can be extremely difficult to control, and very few products are available to manage it.

Fortunately, Quali-Pro Flumishield SC delivers pre-emergent control of many weeds found in the desert landscapes of Arizona, including Globe Chamomile. Applicators seeking to control this invasive weed should apply Flumishield SC to listed sites at a rate of 10-12 fl. oz. per acre and have the 2(ee) bulletin in their possession when applying.

Use Sites

Dormant Bermudagrass on residential sites, golf courses, and sod farms; around established woody ornamentals in landscapes, container and field grown conifers and deciduous trees (including Christmas trees)

Non-crop areas: around buildings, fencerows, gravel surfaces, driveways, ground mats and pads

Mode of Action

A Group 14 N-phenyl-imide herbicide. The mode of action in this chemistry family is inhibition of protoporphyrinogen oxidase (PPO), an enzyme necessary for chlorophyll and heme biosynthesis. Formulated as a soluble concentrate, it contains 4lbs./gal active ingredient of Flumioxazin.
